

Whereas, Howard’s license expired on June 30, 2005, and Howard has not applied for reinstatement or renewal of his license since the expiration;

Whereas, Howard neither admits nor denies the allegations of the Complaint, but agrees to resolve this matter by the entry of this Agreed Order;

Therefore, it is hereby agreed and ordered that should Howard seek to reinstate his license in the Commonwealth, Howard agrees to the license being probated for six months and further agrees that in addition to the legal requirements for reinstatement, he shall complete 7 hours of CE on the proper roles of the OT/L and the OTA/L in the practice of occupational therapy;
