A copy of the ordinary and emergency administrative regulations listed above are enclosed for your files. The information below provides an overview of the standard KRS Chapter 13A timeline. Please note that effective dates or expiration dates may be impacted by legislation or other statutes.

Emergency regulation

Pursuant to KRS 13A.190, an emergency administrative regulation becomes effective upon filing with our office and, unless an extension on the accompanying ordinary is requested, is set to expire either in 270 days (for this regulation on **April 2, 2027**) or when replaced by its corresponding ordinary regulation, whichever occurs first. This emergency regulation is tentatively scheduled for full review by the Administrative Regulation Review Subcommittee at its **SEPTEMBER 2026** meeting. We will notify you of the date and time of this meeting once it has been scheduled. Pursuant to KRS 13A.280, **if** comments are received during the public comment period, a Statement of Consideration for this emergency regulation would be due **by noon on September 15, 2026**.

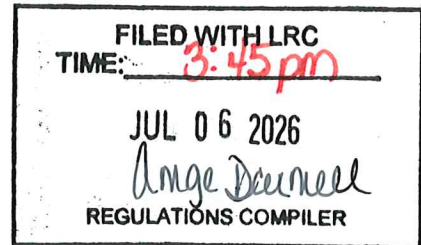
Ordinary regulation

We will notify you of the date and time of this meeting once it has been scheduled. Pursuant to KRS 13A.280, **if** comments are received during the public comment period, a Statement of Consideration for this ordinary regulation or a one-month extension request would be due **by noon on October 15, 2026**.

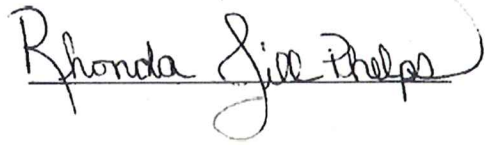
